LAGOONS EU FP7 Project - Open position for researcher in Application of assessment approach tools for coastal lagoons management

The University of Aveiro (UAVR) invites applications for a **six month** position, starting on June 2013 for a period of six months, with possible renovation, depending of the possibilities and interests of the University, to work as an experienced researcher in Application of assessment approach tools for coastal lagoons management at the Department of Biology & CESAM (Centre for Environmental and Marine Studies), under the scope of EU project LAGOONS - Integrated water resources and coastal zone management in European lagoons in the context of climate change (<http://lagoons.web.ua.pt/>).

The position is equivalent to Assistant Researcher, (index 195), working in part-time (80%), **1702 euros/month, gross salary**. The position involves participation in the LAGOONS project, specifically the application of assessment approach tools for coastal lagoons management and the scenario analysis for integrated coastal lagoons management in a Pan-European context

The purpose is to apply different assessment tools to evaluate coastal lagoons management scenarios, namely the DPSIR framework.

Candidates must present the following profile:

- PhD in Biology, Ecology; Environmental Engineering, Environmental Economy or related areas;
- Previous experience in the application of assessment approach tools for coastal lagoons;
- To be author or co-author of articles in journals listed in Science Citation Index in the related scientific area;
- Ability to Integrate a multidisciplinary team;
- Very good communication skills in writing and speaking English.

Outstanding experience and scientific productivity, measured through: citations and the impact factor of journals of published papers, will be the main factor of evaluation. If deemed necessary, the candidate will be called in for an interview.

Applications must include a Cover Letter indicating the candidate's motivation for this position, a detailed CV, with reference to ISI publications, dated and signed, contact information, two recommendation letters, copy of certificates of academic and professional qualifications, and of an identification document (passport:/identity card or equivalent). All documents must be in PDF format, in order to be accepted. Failure to comply with the deadline for submission, as well as the lack of or late submission of the documents mentioned above determines the exclusion of the selection process. Candidates who do not meet the conditions mentioned within this call will not be considered for selection.

The academic and professional profile(s) of candidate(s) will be considered on an individual basis regarding their suitability to the requirements of the position, maintaining this institution the freedom to contract, reserving however the right not to do so regardless of the results achieved in this call.

This call for interest does not render the right to any contract resulting from the relative comparison of the curricula presented. It envisages only a future invitation to potential candidates in accordance with Article 14 of Decree-Law No. 125/99, of 20/Apr, taking in consideration the relevance of curricula and the opportunity and needs at the University of Aveiro.
